The European Space Agency and Future Earth have awarded **EUR: 29,960** (see section “2. Payment schedule”) to Universidad Nacional de Córdoba for the activity: **Heat waves’ impact on urban population: a South American case in the climate change context (HEATCORDOBA)**

### I. Conditions

The following conditions must be agreed upon for the grant to be awarded:

- a. ESA-Future Earth funding can support direct costs or the use of funds for salaries. Costs of overheads incurred by the host institution can be up to a maximum of 25%.
- b. The activity should complete no later than 18 months after kick-off.

**Please note:** any balance must be refunded to the Swedish Hub of Future Earth, in the case that the activity is not carried out (i.e. non-submission of reporting required listed in clause III). Universidad Nacional de Córdoba shall repay any funds that are spent in breach of this Agreement upon written request by Swedish Hub of Future Earth.

### II. Payment schedule

Future Earth shall remit payments for the funding award that will be paid in 2 installments, upon receiving an fund request (invoice) from Universidad Nacional de Córdoba (via email to [8024791892@proccountor.apixscan.se](mailto:8024791892@proccountor.apixscan.se) and CC [sweden@futureearth.org](mailto:sweden@futureearth.org) and Therese Oretég: [therese.oreteg@futureearth.org](mailto:therese.oreteg@futureearth.org)). The applicable Oanda Base Rate at the time of the transfer should apply for transfers in other currencies than SEK.

- a. SEK 172,000 (EUR 15,000) of the full award on receipt of fund request (invoice) no later than 30 June 2025.
- b. SEK equivalent to EUR 14,960 (to be confirmed upon transfer of the funds) to be invoiced 9 months after kick-off and no later than 30 June 2026 on submission of the Mid-term progress report and IGARSS abstract submission due by month 9.

### III. Reporting Requirements

The following reports of a professional quality must be submitted:

- 1) **Mid-term progress report** (due month 9 after kick-off)
- 2) **IGARSS Abstract submission**
- 3) **Final Presentation and written Final Report, and submitted journal manuscript, and links to WEB-GIS published risk maps for Cordoba city, at an urban scale** all submitted to the ESA-Future Earth Joint Programme fund manager (CC [sweden@futureearth.org](mailto:sweden@futureearth.org)) by month 18 after kick-off. The Final Report should summarise the project’s scientific activities, outputs and include recommendations on next steps. The Final presentation can take place online or at a suitable conference/meeting (to be agreed with the ESA-Future Earth Joint Programme fund manager).
- 4) **Financial report** – see guidance below:

*Financial Reporting Requirements*

- A completed **Financial Report** comprising a financial statement and supporting documents: after the project closes, please update your budget plan by listing actual costs and expenses incurred, copy all receipts, and provide a statement verifying these (Comments and Signature) and return as a PDF attachment to [sweden@futureearth.org](mailto:sweden@futureearth.org) and CC Therese Oretg (therese.oretg@futureearth.org).
- The applicant must keep a copy of the **receipt** for each expense listed to be provided upon request.
- The applicant must retain a complete copy of the financial report.

**IV. Mode of Payment of the grant**

Payment will be by bank transfer, after the lead institute has sent an invoice to Swedish Hub of Future Earth. Payment will be made on full execution of the reporting requirements stated in this Agreement.

**V. Accessibility of the data**

In the event that data related to the workshops is generated, we encourage organisers to ensure it is accessible through submission to a database and follows FAIR data sharing principles. Information on how the data can be accessed must be included in the final report.

**VI. ESA and Future Earth Recognition**
